DESCRIPTION: This series will concentrate on interpretive approaches of four major religions: Buddhism, Islam, Christianity and Judaism: Juxtaposition of Mysticism and Kabbalah with the four major beliefs. The focus will be on the directions of reasoning and thoughts on mysticism within the proper historical context. The classes provide a unique perspective of life within these four major religions.
